

Nice, cool payday in Irving

Three runners had nice \$300 payday at the Four Seasons Cool Run 5K and 10K at Las Colinas in Irving on Oct. 25. Lisa Cron

(who's featured on the Side Trips page) won the women's 5K (18:34) and the 10K (37:17) to pocket \$150 for each victory; Fiona Green (featured on this page) won the women's masters in both races (20:19, 41:34) and Ernesto Caballero won the men's masters in both races (16:43, 33:24) to win \$150 for each victory.

The 5K men's winner, Eric Lacross, won his \$150 by edging Agustin Hernandez as both were timed in 16:23. Just steps behind were Kiplimo Chemirmir, Diego Esorici and Dave Matlack. Clint Bell took the men's 10K top prize with a 31:36 with 16-year-old Jeffrey Arnier Jr. not far behind in 31:51 Agustin Hernandez third in 32:50 (the three are pictured at top with Arnier, Hernandez and Bell, left to right) Lisa Cron, 29, had a fairly easy victory in the 5K as runner-up was Sonya Correa at 20:05 and third was Green at 20:19. 12-year-old Sydney Brown was fourth in 20:23. Cron also was far in front in the 10K (37:17) as Green was second in 41:34 and Leana Sloan was next at 41:55. Sandra Ricaud was fourth in 42:17. Both Sloan and Ricaud are 46 (women pictured are Green, Cron and Sloan, left to right). Because the payoffs were awarded for overall and masters, Green is not listed in the results as third or second among the overalls in the respective races because she won the masters first-place money.
