

### **Molly still running fast**



Molly Tucker of Southlake, who was winning women overall titles when she was 10, hasn't been at too many road races lately, but she was among the D-FW competitors at the TAAF Games of Texas Meet in San Antonio the last weekend of July. She came away with two golds in the girls 12-under division, running a 2:28.88 in the 800, and setting a state record for the age division in the 1,600 with a 5:23.32. The previous record was 5:33.14. Molly had some injuries this spring, and a family illness, which limited her road races to the Grapevine Filly Trot, The Uptown Run (Dallas Challenge), and the Hound Dog Hustle.
