

## Big payoffs for some area runners

Two Dallas races drew the bulk of the running crowd Saturday (Sept. 18), and the faster runners took home some cash. At the Addison Oktoberfest, the male and female winners had to hold off close challengers to earn the \$250 top prizes. Joe Beisner of Irving held off Clint Bell of Dallas to win the 5K with a 15:45 on the warm and humid morning. Bell finished with a 15:54. The race for the female title was won by Laurie Shea of Prosper as she was timed in 18:16 and Sonya Correa of Dallas was just behind at 18:24. The runners-up were consoled with \$100 each and the third place finishers won \$50. In the masters division, the male and female winners (Michael Fussell, 17:28, and Cora Turner, 19:24) took home \$100 each. There were 1,410 finishers.

The ever-popular Tour des Fleurs at White Rock Lake had 2,189 finishers in the 10K, 20K and Luke's Challenge 10K. In the Luke's Challenge, Kolin Styles of Holliday and D'Ann Arthur of Dallas won their respective divisions and earned \$500 each. Styles beat Benson Osoro of Dallas by 11 seconds with his 33:43. Arthur had a little more cushion as her 35:55 beat Dawn Grunnagle of Dallas by 34 seconds. The runners-up in the male and female divisions won \$400. Payoffs went to the top eight with the eighth place finisher earning \$50. There were 29 participants in the Challenge.

In the 10K, Julie Sandoval of Fort Worth won the female title with a 41:16 and Dan Clubb of Carrollton won the male division with a 37:30. In the 20K, Logan Sherman of Dallas won with a 1:09:57 and Shaheen Suttar of Dallas won the female division with a 1:23:04. See the results.
