

Chemirmir second in Oklahoma

Kiplimo Chemirmir of Flower Mound, who has been competing in a marathon almost every two weeks this year and who was runner-up at the Cowtown Marathon, finished second again at the A2A, Arbuckles to Ardmore Marathon on Sunday (March 28) in Oklahoma. Though he was neck-and-neck with winner Joel Stansloski of Tulsa through 23 miles, Kiplimo finished more than a minute behind with a 2:35:56 while Stansloski won with a 2:34:23. Other top male finishers from the D-FW area included Trey Bryant of Dallas, fifth with a 3:03:36, Peter-Michael Seidel of Dallas, seventh with a 3:14:52 and the ironman from Southlake, Thomas Okazaki. After running the Joe's Run 5K the day before, Okazaki won the 50-54 division with a 3:24:22, good for 11th place. In the female division, Kristine Hinojos of Keller finished fourth with a 3:39:11. In the half marathon, Rick Hanson of Lewisville finished third with a 1:18:51 and Tyler Johnson was fifth with a 1:19:35. In the female division, Stacie Sauber of Southlake finished sixth with a 1:38:03. Colleen Casey of Grapevine won the female 5K with a 19:30.
