

Top collegians win Run Proud for Dessert

They might have been passing through the area or visiting, but former outstanding Colorado Buffaloes runners and husband-wife Austin Baille and Renee Metivier-Baille posted some impressive winning times at the Run Proud For Dessert in Dallas on Sept. 11. Austin ran a 15:58 to win the male division and Renee finished in 17:02 to take the female title. Austin's indoor 5K best is 14:11. Renee was selected CU's Female Athlete of the Year her senior year when she won the NCAA indoor 3,000 meters, three Big 12 titles and three All-American titles. Her indoor 5K personal best is 15:15.78. She was fourth at the U.S. Championship competition at the Houston Half Marathon this year.
