

Shea, Strait, Correa, Inman add to victory list

Chris Strait of McKinney won his sixth overall title this year in D-FW area races by racing to a 17:04 and winning the North Texas Komen Race For The Cure 5K on Saturday (June 12) morning. Female winner Laurie Shea of Prosper boosted her win column to four this year with her 18:44 over the partial-loop course in Plano. The respective masters winners were Tami Darlington (21:32) and Charles Lee (19:55).

At the Dadfest 5K in Richardson, Sonya Correa boosted her victory record to seven by winning the female title in 18:54. Jim Stitt took his first male title this year with a 17:14. Laura Nelson (20:27) and Joe Landry (18:30) won their respective masters titles.
