

## Nelson, Minyard beat Race To Read field



Laura Nelson of Grapevine and Craig Minyard of Colleyville won the female and male overall titles at the Race To Read 5K in Colleyville on a chill-bump Saturday (Nov. 6) morning. Laura, 45, has won an overall title at least 22 times this year and is planning to run the DRC Half Marathon on Sunday (Nov. 7) in Dallas. She ran a 20:09.8 gun time over a course that was about 30-40 seconds long for several runners because they missed a turn when heavy traffic from a nearby sporting event hampered vision over the course that went through nearby neighborhoods after starting in front of the Colleyville Public Library. Craig, 46, was about 13 seconds late for the start but was still first across the finish line with a gun time of 17:39.5. His chip time was 17:26.6. He had jogged home (about a mile from the race) to get some gloves as the temperature was in the 40s. When he jogged back, the race was set to begin and by the time he crossed the starting mat to activate his computer chip, he was behind several runners and had to weave his way to the front. The event included a 1-mile pet run and a 1-mile fun run, plus there was a bounce house for kids, a swimming pig, and the food included pancakes, sausage, juice, coffee and bananas
