

Riggins, Chemirmir win Heels and Hills Half

Camille Riggins of Grand Prairie, who said she was retiring from marathons after winning the Cowtown in February, can shine at half the marathon distance, too. The 34-year-old won the Heels and Hills Half Marathon in Irving on a relatively cool Sunday morning (May 2) with a 1:26:15.3. She was second overall, behind male winner Kiplimo Chemirmir, who won the Fort Worth Marathon in November of 2009 and has challenged in several since then. Kiplimo crossed the finish line in 1:11:50.9. The event, which included a 10K and 5K, had 1,170 finishers. The half was the biggest attraction as 662 finished the 13.1-mile distance.
