



### **Fast crowd shows up at Run For Riders**

With American Airlines tickets used as bait for the 10K winners of the Run For The Riders, several of the D-FW areas faster runners showed up Saturday morning, April 3, at the Fort Worth Stock Yards in an attempt to snatch the prize. Joshua Trevino of Irving outkicked Stephen Ariga, a Kenyan living in the area, the last half mile to win the male division in 31:44.9. It was about a 15-second PR for Trevino, who won the Butterfly Boogie 5K last week in Dallas and is third on this year's 5K Fastest Times list. Joshua said it was the first time in four tries that he has beaten Ariga, and this time it paid off with the airline ticket. Winning the female 10K division was Debbie Arzola in an unofficial 37:35.6. She had no close challengers and breezed to victory to claim the ticket. The 5K offered \$100 to the winners, but unfortunately the female winner couldn't collect. The female 5K winner was Rachel Williams, 15, of Tolar in 20:51.9 and taking the men's title was a surprised Bob Scully, 50, of Fort Worth in 19:03.2.
