

### **Sherman, Arthur top talented Komen Dallas field**

Logan Sherman of Dallas, the Cowtown Marathon winner in February, showed he can go fast in the shorter distances, too. Sherman beat a talented field in the Komen Dallas Race For The Cure 5K on a chilly Saturday (Oct. 16) morning to claim a round-trip airline ticket and \$750 in North Park Gold Gift Coins. In the female division, D'Ann Arthur of Dallas, who has competed in several triathlons, also proved adept at the 5K distance to take the top prizes. Sherman, 24, ran a 15:14 to hold off Clint Bell, 31, of Wilmer, who came in at 15:28 and won \$300 worth of the gift coins. Joe Beisner, 37, of Irving finished third with a 15:49 and earned \$100 of the gift coins. Arthur, 23, crossed the finish line in 16:37 to beat runner-up Erin Bedell, 23, of Flagstaff, Ariz., by 14 seconds. Dawn Grunnagle, 32, of Dallas was third with a 17:02.

Masters winners also earned \$300 in the gift coins and the top seniors (65-older) won \$300 in the gift coins. Ken Hall, 46, of Colleyville took the men's masters title in 16:20, and Ed Swiatocha, 49, of Keller won the seniors award with a 17:46. In the female division, Lisa Coleman, 47, of Cedar Hill won the masters division with a 19:01 and Linda Kelly, 59, of Dallas took the seniors division with a 22:04. Not only did the race boast one of the talent-deepest fields in the D-FW area this year, but it also had approximately 21,000 registrants
