

## Bell wins fifth Millet Mile title

Clint Bell of Dallas won his fourth consecutive Plano Pacers Millet Mile on Saturday (June 27), holding off challenger Juan Sanchez.

Bell raced to a 4:26, three seconds off the record he set in 2007, to beat Sanchez by four seconds. The win was Bell's fifth in six years. He skipped the race in 2005.

There were several records set, including by women's winner Becky Angeles (pictured), whose 5:24 beat her previous record of 5:29. The race honors Dan Millet, a former PP president and who organized and conducted several events over several years in the Dallas area. Dan, who also served as the Country Country Club of Dallas president (now the Dallas Running Club), has been battling Myelodysplasia since 2005. He was given only two years to live, but after undergoing an experimental drug regimen since 2007, he has amazingly improved from being wheelchair bound to gaining back most of his abilities. He's shown giving Bell the men's overall winning trophy. All of us who have known Dan for the past several years wish him the best.
