

## Carroll runners, couple win at Dragon's Fire 5K on a cold night in Southlake

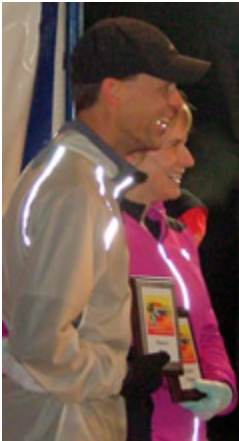


Molly Tucker, female overall winner (left), and Addisyn Green, winner of the 9-10 age division

The Dragon's Fire 5K started after dark on a cold, calm Friday night (Dec. 4) at Central Market in Town Square in Southlake. Although snow had not arrived as forecast, the temperature was in the mid-30s at the start of the race and the sky was crystal clear as sunset came thirty minutes or so before the race.

A certified 5K, a mostly flat course, and no wind provided for good conditions and some fast times, even if a few cars had to be dodged in the subdivision adjacent to the start.

Trevor Gilley, 15, of Fort Worth, who runs for the Carroll High School cross country and track teams, won the overall men's category with a 16:54.8.



Molly Tucker, 13, of Southlake, who runs for the Carroll Middle School cross country and track teams, won the women's overall category with a 19:04.5.
