



Jaime Barajas and Wendy Ragle won the male and female overall titles at Sunday's (Jan. 25) Fort Worth Runners Club's Einstein Run at Trinity Park in Fort Worth. Barajas won in 40:20 and Ragle, who moved back to the D-FW three months ago after attending college and living in Memphis, Tenn., the past 10 years, won in 42:58. However, she and other runners said the course probably was closer to 6.5 miles rather than the 10K (6.2 miles) distance. Apparently, Einstein was having a bad day with his calculations. Ragle played soccer and basketball at Duncanville High before attending the University of Memphis. She ran track at Memphis, but said she hadn't run a road race in three years. Among her goals as she rounds back into running shape is to beat her 5-minute mile PR. Her 10K PR is 39:08. Ragle said the Cowtown Half Marathon is a possibility if her coach, Chris Phelan, lets her. When Barajas finished, it appeared he wouldn't be declared the winner because he hadn't paid. Barajas said he was rushing to make the start and didn't have time to register, but he registered and paid after he finished so that he wouldn't be disqualified.
