Two Metroplex teams came back winners from the Beach To Bay Relays conducted May 19 in Corpus Christi.

The women's masters team of Wonder Women, which surprised everyone last year by winning the overall title, came back to win the Women's Masters title this year. The team of Ruthie Tate, Frances McKissick, Annabell Lee, Yolanda Hopping, Sandra Ricaud and Fiona Green won with a 2:55:20, which was fourth overall among the women. Fiona was a replacement for last year's team member Sonia Soprenuk, who was injured.

Taking the Senior Masters Men title was the Fort Worth Running Club's Senior Road Dawgs. The team of Don Nelson, Richard Neill, Bob Smeby, Darrell Davis, Jeff Amier Sr., and Robert Isles set a division course record with their 2:38:37.

The Fort Worth Flyers/Voladores finished fifth in the Senior Masters Men division in 2:58:17. Team
