

Cook wins again in San Francisco

Andrew Cook, the new Flower Mound High School track coach, won the San Francisco Marathon on July 29 for the second consecutive year. Cook, who has qualified for the 2008 Olympic Trials, won in 2:25:57, 49 seconds faster than his winning time of last year.

He broke away from his challengers after running across the Golden Gate Bridge, some nine miles into the race. Runner-up was Michael Wardian of Virginia with a time of 2:28:50. Another Metroplex top 100 finisher was Michael Held, 41, of Dallas. He finished 85th among the 4,250 finishers with a 3:10:31.
