Molly Tucker followed her personal-best winning effort on April 28 with another overall female victory at the Dragons Fire Race 5K in Southlake with an 18:38. She had won the Hound Dog Hustle the week before with a PR 18:05. At the Dragons Fire, she joined one of her coaches, Lisa Gilbert, in the winner's circle. Gilbert won the female masters title in 23:16.

Britt Koestler, 17, won the overall male title with a speedy 15:51 over what John Tucker described as a hilly course on a high humidity day. Mark Olateju was the masters winner in 20:07.

Molly's 15-year-old brother Matthew finished in 31:32 and said, "I've played four (select soccer tournament) games in one day and two the next, but I never had anything as hard as this," he said of the hills and humidity. He said there were runners quitting along the route.
