

The Half, Nov. 5, 2006

Edward Muge, a member of the AmeriKenyan running club in Santa Fe, N.M., won The Half on Sunday (Nov. 5) at White Rock Lake in Dallas. Muge beat Maclek Miereczko, a Polish runner living in Searcy, Ariz, by more than a minute on the loop course with a time of 1 hour, 5 minutes and 31 seconds. Miereczko finished in 1:06:45.

Muge was coming off an Oct. 23 10K victory in Santa Monica, Calif., where he ran a 29:42.

Favorite Melissa Cook of Denton easily won the women's title with a 1:19:01. Her nearest challenger was Becky Angeles of Nevada, TX, with a 1:22:42. Frances McKissick of Irving, a oft-time masters winner, took the women's 40-older trophy with a 1:27:50 while Fiona Green of Keller, a regular contributor to this web site, finished second in 1:30:37.

Dan Boyle of Manhattan, Kan., the 2004 Cowtown Marathon winner, won the men's masters title with a 1:10:43.

There were 3,069 finishers in the 13.1-mile race.
