

Records set at White Rock

The men's and women's course records were set Sunday (Dec. 10) at the Wellstone White Rock Marathon in Dallas.

Moses Kororia of Kenya ran a personal best of 2:12:04 to win the men's race in record time, and Russian Svetlana Ponomarenko set the women's record with her personal-best time of 2:29.55.

Kororia won \$10,000 for his first-place victory and a \$25,000 bonus given to the first runner across the finish line. For the second year, the elite women were given a head start, this time by 17 minutes, in the Cooper Complete Race To Victory Gender Challenge.

Ponomarenko stayed in front of everyone until about the 24-mile mark when Kororia passed her. She finished about 300 meters behind.

Approximately 3,500 participated in the marathon. There were about 10,000 who ran the 26.2 miles, the half marathon and the relays on the cool morning with temperatures in the 40s and low 50s.
